Ministry of Education, GoI., and Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, are insisting on 100% seeding of APAAR data into the NAD portal, for all the students admitted to various programmes offered by constituent and affiliated colleges, from the academic year 2021 onwards. Among the many, some of the benefits of seeding academic records of students into the NAD portal are as follows.

1. Streamlining of students academic records and achievements.
2. Simplifying the mobility of students from one institution to other.
3. Ease of process while applying for higher education or employment.
4. Life long academic identity and facility to skilling, reskilling and upskilling.
5. Students can effortlessly access their academic journey and real-time performance visibility.
6. It serves as an identity proof to avail benefits as envisaged by schools, governments and universities.

In view of the above, AU Computer Centre updated the ABC data seeding in the NAD portal for all the students of whose ABC/APAAR ids are available with the university. Some of the students admitted during the academic year 2021 and after are not yet submitted their ABC/APAAR ids to the university, due to which we are finding it difficult to meet the targets set by the regulatory agencies. To facilitate the students, AUCC created a facility and made available at (i) in the department/institution logins of every college and (ii) on the main page of the Andhra University under "QUICK LINKS" (top left corner of the webpage), to update the ABC/APAAR ids of the individuals. Hence, we request you to direct the concerned to inform all the stake holders to update their ABC/APAAR ids using the above facility.
